

Bring your well-behaved dog to the Meet the Breed Showcase on a buckle or slip collar and with a grooming brush and \$15 to see if Rover has what it takes to be a respectable member of society. The CGC test is a 10-step test designed by the American Kennel Club (AKC) to reward good-mannered dogs. 
